PARKS

Hooray park improvements are on the way. These parks affect us all, owners and renters, young and old. Their original and continuing purpose is to provide a safe haven for our children (grandchildren) to play, safely "off the streets". Improvement plans are **multi-phased** to spread costs over several years and enable resident involvement and inputs to make our parks incorporate multiple features, as desired by you and the majority of others within our community.

Phase 1 is in work, new 8' high play sets have been purchased and will be arriving soon. This new equipment is targeted primarily at our younger (ages up to 12) residents; however, will include new "replacement" belt swings for the older existing "up-right" structures, for older kids. A conscientious decision was made to switch to powder-coated, steel and high-density plastic (no splinters, warping, or rough edges), for longevity, but yet not get blazing hot during our mid-day sun. Swing seat chains have rubberized grips to prevent little fingers from getting pinched. All equipment is touted to be "Maintenance Free" with weather-resistant, heavy duty galvanized steel, zinc-coated chains, UV-protected plastic, and marine-quality decking, to resist rusting, fading, and discoloration.

Within the near future, each park (playground) will have a minimum of: 6 belt swings, 2 high back, full bucket (baby) swings; 1 three blade propeller swing; 1 rubberized steel trapeze bar with gym rings; 2 9-foot wavy slides; monkey bars with fire pole; and an elevated/covered clubhouse-deck with rope-ladder, regular-ladder and 3-D circular climbing wall accesses. Lastly, rounding out this phase of new equipment installations, is a Geometric Dome Climber with plastic rock climbing hand grips.

<u>Phase 2</u> is unfunded and unscheduled at this point, will replace the remaining older "up-right" swing structure in both parks with a conventional "A-Frame" 3 position, 10' high swing set. This new equipment, of course, will be of the same materials and quality as the Phase 1 installations.

<u>Phase 3</u> "Park Improvements" is on the agenda for the upcoming semi-annual community meeting, scheduled for October 22nd. Future suggested play equipment additions are: Tether-Ball; Teeter-Totters (See-Saw); Fixed-Position Spring-Mounted Rocking Horses; a stand-alone higher slide and a Merry-Go-Round. Suggested bigger ticket items, to date, include: a half-court basketball pad; a dog park; and safety/security camera capabilities.

So please, plan to attend this upcoming community meeting to discuss these and other "Park Improvements" possibilities. These are our parks, we <u>can</u> incorporate our desired improvement.

The one thing we can not do, is take the PLAY out of the parks!

Volunteers are still needed for ground safety material covering installations, equipment assembly, and equipment securing installations. If you would like to help, join the discussions on

CODE ENFORCEMENT

DEED RESTRICTIONS

Reminder, our Deed Restrictions are available on the web site.

- Boats, trailers, jet skis, etc. are required to be placed behind fencing.
- Vehicles' blocking the sidewalk is a Melbourne Code
- Violation, as well as vehicles parked on the street facing the wrong direction
- Vehicles must have current tag registration and be in operating condition. In addition, vehicles are not allowed to be parked on the grass

GROUNDS MAINTENANCE

Among other things always going on is the maintenance of our east and west canals. We have a landscaping service that mows and trims the trees along the embankments, and an environmental company that treats the water for algae growth. The landscaping service also mows and maintains the grass in the front entrance area and the grass in the east and west playgrounds. Additionally, this summer a major tree trimming project was completed on both ponds to improve the looks of the community and safe accessibility to our avid fisherman.

CRIME PREVENTION

With the coming of the holiday season, we all are now spending a great deal of time and money decorating our homes. Unfortunately, our beautiful homes may also interest those who would like to profit through crime.. To make it difficult and therefore unattractive for these folks to target Kingsmill be sure you take the following steps:

- Park cars in garages if at all possible
- Keep the garage door closed, even if you are at home
- Always lock car doors (even in the garage)
- Do not leave valuables inside your car
- If you have to park your car outside the garage, remove the garage door opener
- **NEVER** leave your keys inside the car
- Never leave your car running unattended
- Keep your doors locked

Your annual Kingsmill Homeowners Association dues directly supports the Homeowner Association. In case you don't know, the annual dues help the HOA maintain the following:

- Our entryways require
 landscaping maintenance
 (mowing, watering, tree care,
 mulching and periodic plantings)
- Maintenance of the east and west retention ponds
- Landscaping maintenance of the trees and grass in the east and west park playgrounds as well as Playground equipment maintenance and replacement in both parks
- Kingsmill HOA must carry liability insurance
- The Kingsmill ARC must review property change submittals (fences, sheds, exterior paint color, code violations, etc.) and enforce covenants
- The HOA maintains, through the efforts of a volunteer, a website for the community
- The HOA sends out periodic newsletters to inform the community
- The HOA provides a holiday light display at the front entryway each year
- The HOA holds a community garage sale including advertising in local newspapers, the Kingsmill Grapevine and garage sale signs

NO SOLICITING

Remember Kingsmill is a "NO SOLICITING" neighborhood. It is posted at the entrance to our community. You can remind any solicitor that they are in violation and can be told to leave. They should do so without any conflict. We can notify MPD to ban them if necessary.
