### **OLD BUSINESS**

### **Front Entrance**

A \$1,600 (approx.) quote for new plants/shrubs at the front entrance had been received. A contractor has not responded to calls. Another contractor will be tried. Ongoing

# Parks/Playgrounds

The cost to install door-sized gates on the retention pond fences at both parks is still in-work. A fence company was contacted and the inspection of the fences at both retention ponds was done to provide recommendations/quotes to make repairs. However, the company refused repairing, only replacement for an exorbitant amount. Another company will be contacted. Ongoing

A \$21,250 quote for playground equipment was received which exceeds the budget of \$6,000. The company that provided the current equipment will be contacted for alternative pricing. Ongoing

# **Drainage Impact Concern**

A letter has been received by homes on Reign Street requesting a temporary easement to allow access to the area for storm water management excavation. This work has been postponed and the letters will be requested when work resumes.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

### **Architectural Review Committee**

Joe Wichart, ARC Chairman has received pushback by some owners while he attempts to remind them of our HOA requirement for approvals of various property modifications.

## Retention Pond Grass/Tree Trimming, etc.

Numerous complaints have been received concerning the grass not being trimmed next to the fence. The possibility of getting a different lawn service contractor was discussed. Trees and shrubs along the fence lines also need trimming. Erosion on the pond walls has been increasing. The county has piles of rip-rap concrete chunks that might be available to use.

Locks on gates having access to the retention ponds were recommended to have the same code **except** the one on the east pond which will remain the same for both Longwood and Kingsmill access. A motion was made to do so which was seconded and passed unanimously.

### **Miscellaneous**

Some of the entrance lights around the palm trees continue to trip the GFI probably due to moisture. Since there are five GFIs, it's difficult to determine which is the problem. Removal of these lights was recommended. Ongoing

The next meeting was scheduled for **July16**, **2020**, **7:00 PM** at the West Pond Park. This will be the Annual Meeting and the selection of next year's Board members. Attendees are asked to bring chairs. The meeting was closed at 8:14 by Dennis Thompson
